HOW DO WE GET CERTIFIED?

This is a question that is often asked, this is not meant to be difficult,

- 1- Review and complete the Continuing Support of the District Youth Protection Policy statement basically, you agree to adhere to the district youth protection policy.
- 2-Establish a committee of at least three people as your youth activities committee each person is given a term to expire in 1; 2 & 3 years hereafter one person is appointed each year to a 3 year term, with the most senior member becoming the chair.
- 3-List local services

For example list of professional services might look like this--
